

2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKET

Receipt Deadline - April 1, 2024

Future Builders of America (FBA) is program of Home Builders Institute, a 501(c)3, non-profit organization. The FBA mission is to engage in construction-related educational activities that help young people understand and pursue rewarding careers in the construction industry.

FBA created a scholarship fund to assist in addressing the pressing need for a better educated and trained construction industry workforce. Traditionally, at least 10% of FBA's general operating budget is set aside to be awarded annually through the scholarship program. Since 2000, FBA has awarded over \$120,000 in scholarship funds to students interested in a career in the construction industry.

Scholarship applications are available to FBA Chapters in January of each year. Awards should be available in May and will be paid according to the type of scholarship being applied for. FBA offers three types of scholarships as noted:

<u>Tools of the Trade</u> – Intended for High School Students going directly into the construction industry and who are in need of assistance to purchase the proper tools for that particular job. Scholarships will be paid directly to the employer to assist with purchasing the required tools.

<u>Accelerated Skills Training Programs (AST)</u> – Intended for Students that are pursuing short–term training in a variety of construction skills. Scholarships will be paid directly to the training institution.

<u>College Tuition</u> – Intended for Students in good standing at a Florida secondary education program or post-secondary education who are pursuing a construction related career. Scholarships will be paid directly to the school.

Application Deadline	Applications should be received at the FBA office by Friday, April 1, 2024 . Applications received after the deadline may not be considered.
Eligibility	Students should be Florida high school seniors or currently enrolled in a post-secondary program in Florida and are pursuing a construction industry related career. Chapter FBA Participation is preferable but not required.
Process	Applications are reviewed individually and objectively scored by an independent committee – criteria include academic performance, financial need, construction experience, and participation in FBA activities.

To be considered, the following <u>MUST BE INCLUDED</u> with application depending on the type of scholarship applying for:

- 1) A minimum of ONE Academic Recommendation is required in a sealed envelope with the recommender's signature written across the seal. TWO recommendations would be helpful but is not required. Required for all application types.
- 2) Brief Essay by applicant explaining your interest in becoming a professional in the construction industry. Identify and describe your experience with the construction industry and career goals. (Please do not exceed one page, minimum font size is 12pt. If written, please print). Required for all application types.
- 3) 1st page ONLY of the most recent 1040 for head of household (Black out any SSN's). Required for AST Program and College Tuition Applications.
- 4) School Transcripts Required for College Tuition Applications only.
